Dear Paris,

I know we've had our differences over the years, especially when you used to wear fur, but now we have one thing in common: jail! Oh, Paris, I hope you're settling in all right and keeping your spirits up. I know it can have its stressful moments, but it also causes one to reflect on life.

I was pleased to read that your predicament has inspired you to become active in causes. Toward that end, on behalf of PETA and our 1.6 million members, I'm writing to ask for your help in a campaign seeking to protect a very different kind of jailbird: chickens, who, sadly, are exempt from the Humane Slaughter Act and suffer unimaginably on factory farms.

For four years, KFC officials have ignored countless pleas to eliminate the worst abuses that their chickens suffer. When the birds are crammed into tiny cages, their legs and wings often get broken. Their throats are slit while they're still conscious, and many are even scalded to death in defeathering tanks. Unlike inmates at the jail in L.A., these animals get no reprieve or medical treatment.

Would you consider joining the likes of Paul McCartney, Pam Anderson, and The Rev Al Sharpton, all of whom have spoken up to help with this effort?
