Dear Ms. Miller,

As a proud New Hampshire native, I'm writing on behalf of PETA and our more than 1.8 million members and supporters with a suggestion for a way to make NHCTC-Manchester stand out from the crowd while helping to fight animal abuse: Change its name to KentuckyFriedCruelty.com Community College.

Why KentuckyFriedCruelty.com? KFC's suppliers abuse the more than 850 million chickens raised and killed each year for KFC's restaurants in ways that would warrant felony cruelty-to-animals charges if dogs or cats were the victims. KFC's suppliers breed chickens to grow so large that many suffer crippling injuries, slit their throats while they are still conscious, and scald many to death in defeathering tanks. They cram chickens into waste-filled warehouses by the tens of thousands and force the birds to live with the decaying corpses of other chickens. Workers at a KFC "Supplier of the Year" slaughterhouse were documented tearing the heads off live birds, spitting tobacco into their eyes, spray-painting their faces, and stomping on them.

PETA is simply asking KFC to adopt the recommendations made by its own former animal welfare advisors and eliminate the worst abuses of the birds raised and killed for its restaurants. Five advisors have resigned in frustration—one said that she felt they were "being used" and that the council "never had any meetings."

**By changing your school's name to KentuckyFriedCruelty.com Community College, you'll send the message that the school opposes cruelty to animals while branding it with an unforgettable name.** You'll also be associating your school with kind people worldwide—including Sir Paul McCartney, His Holiness The Dalai Lama, and The Rev. Al Sharpton—who have spoken out against KFC's cruelty.
