## **BEFORE THEY'RE COOKED IN YOGHURT AND SPICES, THEY'RE MARINATED IN URINE AND FAECES.**

**Some ships that carry sheep from Australia to the Middle East to be slaughtered for food can hold more than 100,000 animals at a time.**

During the journeys, many of the sheep become sick or injured, and some of them are thrown into the sea or ground up in macerators while alive and conscious; the rest remain onboard in filth until they reach the Middle East.

**The journeys can last weeks, but the animals' bladders cannot.** By the end of the journey, they often stand knee-deep in their own urine and faeces.

Ammonia fumes from the accumulated urine have caused animals to go blind or suffer respiratory failure. Urine and faeces can contaminate the sheep's food. Open, bloody wounds often go untreated, helping to spread disease.
